

# 2. National Queer Arts Festival








### June 9-July 2

The 26th annual **National Queer Arts Festival (NQAF)** is a hybrid virtual/in-person art festival taking place throughout the Bay Area. This year's theme is "**Murmurations of Queer Power,"** a celebration of work by QTI2SBIPOC (Queer, Trans, Gender Nonconforming, Intersex, Two-spirit, Black, Indigenous, People of Color) artists. NQAF has presented over 800 events since it began in 1998.







#### June 9-11

This free film festival has showcased works from **Queer women of color** for 19 years running. See six films across three days at the Presidio Theatre, along with a panel about disability justice and a free reception on June 10. The festival is presented by the Queer Women of Color Media Arts Project, and their Filmmaker Training Program has helped to produce over 465 new films over the years.









#### June 10

The SF Giants will play at home against the Chicago Cubs on June 10. In honor of SF Pride, the **first 20,000 fans to arrive will receive a rainbow SF Giants Pride jersey**, presented by Gilead. Make sure to arrive early if you want a chance at snagging one, because the jerseys will go first-come first-served and there's no special event ticket to receive them.

- **Night: Halcyon celebration (6pm-late):** Halcyon will host evening Pride festivities in its large modern warehouse space in SoMa.


## 19. Stroll along the Rainbow Honor Walk
